## **White Queen**

70-75 days. Creamy white in color this heirloom producing 4-8 oz. fruit. Has one of the best flavors of all tomatoes - fragrant, fruity and intensely sweet.

### **Box Car Willie**

80 days. Smooth orange-red, slightly flattened, Jersey-type slicing tomato. Rich and juicy, 10-16 oz. fruit

#### **Paul Robeson**

90 days. Distinctive sweet and smoky flavor with 7-10 oz. fruit that are a black-brick color.

## **Green Zebra**

75 days. Beautiful chartreuse color with deep lime-green stripes. Flesh is bright green and very rich tasting, sweet with a sharp bite to it.

## Ananas Noir (Black Pineapple)

80 days. Smooth, multi-colored fruit (green, yellow and purple mix), 1 1/2 lbs. Bright green flesh with deep red streaks. Outstanding flavor. Sweet and smoky with a hint of citrus.

## **Super Sweet 100**

65 days. A hybrid that produces long, fruit-bearing stems holding 100 or more of exceptionally sweet, red, cherry tomatoes.

### **Yellow Brandywine**

90 days. Large, golden-yellow fruit. Many believe better tasting than Pink Brandywine.

# Sungold

65 days. Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes. Ripens in long clusters of 10 to 15 fruits.

## **Cherokee Purple**

80 days. An old Cherokee Indian heirloom. Beautiful deep dusky purple-pink color, superb sweet flavor and very large sized fruit.

## **Mortgage Lifter**

85 days. Large, smooth, 1-lb. pink fruit have a delicious, rich, sweet taste.

### **Pineapple**

75-95 days. Very large and beautiful yellow fruit with red marbling through the flesh. Up to  $1\frac{1}{2}$  pounds. The flavor is very sweet and fruity.
